Indian Sandalwood \$58

It can treat minor cuts and insect bites, help cope with skin hyperpigmentation, and also with stress and fatigue, relieve headaches and insomnia.

Lotus oil \$96

When finding out what essential oils are in Egypt, don't miss such an exotic and rare option as lotus oil. In Ancient Egypt, the lotus was considered a gift from heaven. The tart and sweet smell with hints of cinnamon is part of famous brand fragrances from Dior, Kenzo, Moschino and others. The oil also has healing properties: it can eliminate pain and spasms, increase the body's defenses and normalize heart function.

Helba oil (fenugreek) \$87

It has been used since ancient times as a remedy for treating women's diseases. It contains diosgenin, a substance similar in structure and action to estrogen.

Egyptian Jojoba Oil \$65

There are quite a lot of cosmetics and each of them has its own purpose. Jojoba oil is a universal product and its benefits are invaluable in various areas.

We are talking about the large-flowered type - grandiflorum. This is the jasmine used by SHAHBOZOV'S® perfumers, it grows in Egypt.

Comoros Vanilla \$77

It has long been used by perfumers in compositions of various classes and directions. At the same time, the Masters prefer to use vanilla, which is grown in the Comoros Islands (previously this country was the main world exporter)

Iris Not for sale

This is the most expensive material in perfumery. The oil is extracted not from the iris flower, but from its root. At the same time, to obtain oil from 1 iris, you need to spend at least 6.5 years. This time is necessary for the plant to give color, increasing in the bulb, which after 3 years of flowering is dug up and sent for storage. This stage takes another 3 years, during which the bulb will dry out and give its oil drop by drop. It is worth noting that there are about 300 species of iris in the world, but only the Pallida and Florentina varieties are the most valuable in perfumery.

Ambergris \$1,790

This is a substance formed in the digestive tract of the sperm whale, which it gets rid of naturally. Fresh ambergris has a very unpleasant specific smell and is never used in perfumery. But, floating in the sea for several dozen, and sometimes hundreds of years, interacting with air, water and sunlight, the substance acquires an unusual smell, which can be described as salty, marine, mineral.

Ambergris is used in niche fragrances to give them a unique sound and appeal. Natural ambergris is also an excellent fixative for other notes in a composition. However, it is worth noting that in the modern perfume world, natural amber is often replaced by synthetic material, but not in SHAHBOZOV'S®.

Argan oil \$1,690
